



OUTDOOR TEAM BUILDING OPTIONS



Team Initiative Activities (2-4 hrs)

A huge range of *facilitated* problem-solving activities to develop communication, team spirit and develop cohesion both within and across teams. **Pick & Choose, Connections, Pyramid, Maze, Keypunch** & many more challenge the mind more than the body & everyone can participate!



The Amazing Race (2-3 hrs)

Armed with a digital camera and map, the aim of the activity is to use your cunning and team skills to achieve the highest point score possible! Small teams venture out into the local area in search of different checkpoints and further information, not to mention the roadblocks they encounter at various times. A great way to see the points of interest in the local area plus build relationships across the team!



Connexions (3-4 hrs)

This exercise is based on "Cross-Team Collaboration" where larger groups (consisting of smaller sub-teams) benchmark against each other to determine which group was best able to collaborate between its smaller sub-teams. The activity highlights the importance of connecting with other teams in the organisation while providing a fun and enjoyable way to build relationships across teams.



Raft Flotilla (2-4 hrs)

This activity emphasises importance of cross team communication and collaboration with the goal being to secure the highest possible income for the company by collecting market opportunities (buoys floating out on the lake) using rafts constructed by the teams. Each team must first solve some problems to earn money with which to buy the equipment they need to build the rafts. Sharing of ideas & resources is the name of the game!



Water Co Business Simulation (2 hrs)

The team works to optimise profit for the business by delivering services/products (water) to customers (buckets) via a service infrastructure (PVC pipes) which the team must design and construct. The more distant customers offer higher margins for services but require a more extensive infrastructure (extra pipes). The teams have four opportunities to make profit targets whilst reinvesting in pipes to upgrade their infrastructure.



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Project Integration! (3 hours)

The challenge is to sign up a new customer by designing and building a “chair litter” (metaphor for your product/service) in three different locations and deliver these to the customer within a five minute delivery window. If the customer is pleased with delivery performance, consistency and standard of product, then you will be successful in gaining a new key account. An excellent activity to develop integrated teamwork!



Survivor Challenge (3-4 hours)

Based on the “Survivor” theme, teams are challenged with a variety of exciting tasks accumulating points as they go! Challenges are coded as physical, mental or a mixture and there are up to 15 challenges to choose from. You can further enhance the “survivor” atmosphere with flags, bandanas, face paint, chants and music to up the ante!



Adventure Challenge Activities (4-8 hrs)

The perfect way to “stretch the comfort zone”, build self confidence and willingness to embrace change. People experience levels of trust and support rarely experienced in a work environment. Your team will bond through this powerful experience and return to work motivated and ready to take on any challenge! Activities include **High Ropes course, rock climbing, abseiling and caving!**



Adventure Combo! (half or full day)

For those wanting a more physical challenge a “bush journey” format that combines a range of adventure activities into an action packed experience. Various combinations are possible depending on the local area. Typical inclusions are rock-climbing, abseiling or high ropes, mountain biking, rafting or canoeing and caving.
